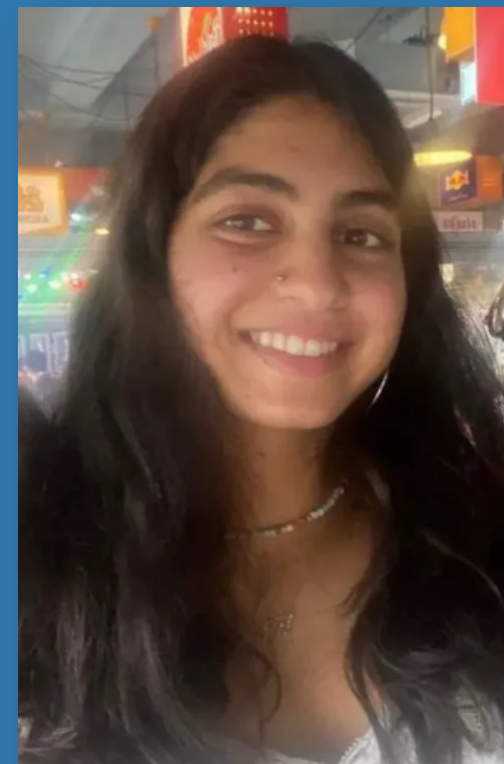
Esha is a third year economics student, with 4 years of expert tutoring experience. She has taught students from beginner to advanced levels, teaching GCSE and A Levels.
